

Ivel Valley School

Overview

- Ivel Valley School, a special school of 180 pupils located in Bedfordshire, found themselves stuck with their telephone system being handled by an outdated PABX.
- The system was difficult to configure and so expensive to maintain.
- The solution to their problems: A Schools Broadband VoIP system.
